Hello Family,

First off are open/filled positions. Our region is needing a co-treasurer, an archivist, a co-secretary, a P.R. secretary, and a co-facilitator for Fellowship Development. Our very own Jan has been voted in as the new Soul to Soul chairperson and McClain has been voted in as the Regional Secretary. Thank you both for your service to our Region.

During open forum there were a few different topics brought up. There was a discussion on moving the location of where Region would meet.
