- Region Motions voted on.
 - 1. Motion 08202023-02 – Per RSC direction, a sub-committee has finalized a CAR motion to establish a new service center – the NA Museum. Motion to approve CAR motion, and submit to next Zonal or Multi-Zonal forum.
 - Intent of motion: The WSO has invested no money in maintaining the archives for over 20 years. We must act now to save our history.
 - Vote 8-1 no abstentions. Vote passes.
 - 2. Motion 08202023-01 – Per request by the May 2023 RSC meeting I have developed a plan and budget for organizing and fire proofing the MAR archive materials. See attached plan, budget, and inventory. Motion to fund the plan.
 - Intent of motion: Overtime, the archives have become scattered and disorganized. Providing fire proofing for the materials will ensure their availability for future generations.
 - Vote 6-3. No abstentions. Vote Passes
- Region has offer from Plains States Zonal to have some all day workshops.
 - Is there an area that would like to hold this event? The location would need to have hotels and an airport – can be municipal airport. We would do this in January.
 - No ideas brought forth.
- Region Motion to send 10k to NAWS, 5k to zonal, 5k to primary purpose projection (P3-Nebraska subcommittee that provides basic texts in prison system to those who request them). Motion passed at Region.
 - Discussion about Region voting w/o taking back to groups.
 - Can't redress because it has already been done but can write a letter to Region about policy not being followed.
 - Mark S. and Rod D. Travis C. and Clayton C. will generate letter to send to Region. Please copy secretary with letter before Region next week
