I am not going to address every single item that was discussed but I thought it is important to see how many open positions there are and the need to fill them. I sent the complete RSC minutes to our Web coordinator, and she has posted them on our web site which is jftareana.net. I feel you should encourage everyone to go and review them as it is important to know what is going on in our region.

A few things that I wanted to make sure everyone was aware of is that the convention is April 26-28, if you go to the region web page marscns.net you can, and I encourage you to reserve your room now for that event as there is only a limited block of rooms available and last year they went pretty fast and some people were SOL. You do not have to pay for them now but you should reserve them. We voted and passed to accept the convention bid for Topeka in 2025.

We tabled a discussion to change the cycle of the RD and Alt RD to a three-year cycle. We voted

and passed to put in a bid for the Multi Zonal forum 2023, it would need to be help in Wichita to accommodate the requirements.

In the open forum the Facilitator (Wayne) acknowledged that the vote to send the money (\$5,000.00) to P3 was not done in the best way and was contrary to policy , it should have been sent back to groups but at this point it is a done deal but he did indicate that he will do better in the future . It was stated that P3 is part of NA and they do a lot of work with NA but it was agreed that what transpired was not in policy to send them money and that is why it should have been sent back to groups. Both motions we voted on passed.

Our redress letter concerning the abovementioned happenstance was placed in and addressed as a new business item as we wanted but when the first set of minutes was sent out it was not listed as such. Thanks to the attention to detail and vigilance f Rod that situation was rectified and the minutes currently reflect our wishes. I read our letter which I can do here today as well if it is needed, and people are not aware of it's contents. As a solution to our redress it was concluded that all RCM'S and elected positions of the RSC answer and address the 8 questions

that we posed in our letter and if an issue ever becomes a conflict it should always be taken back to groups and it was discussed and asked to take back to groups not just issues pertaining to money but all issues. As well we were to take back to groups the idea of having a regional inventory performed by past RD'S .
