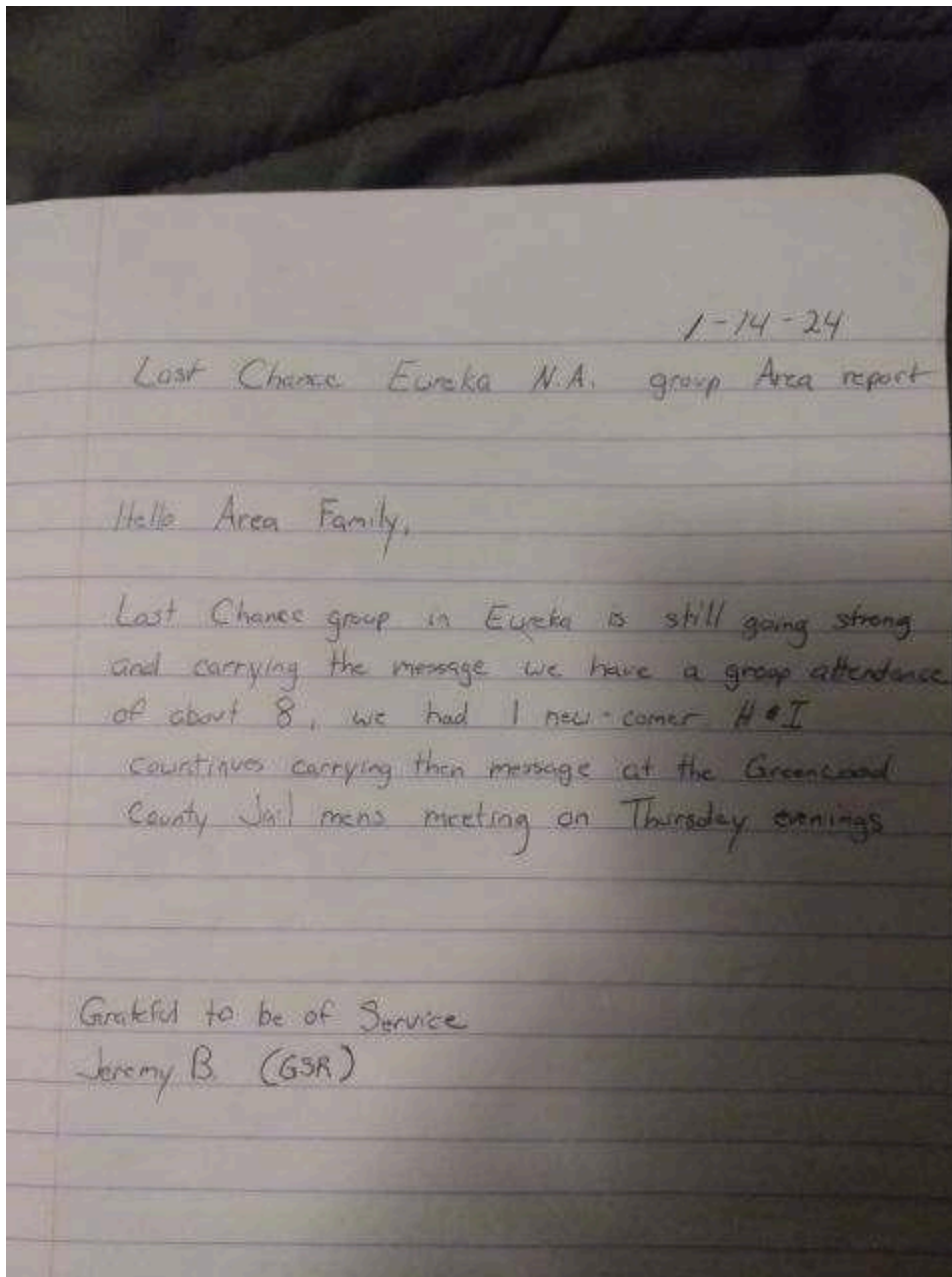

- Request to purchase 8 IP racks with 10 IPs each to be available for groups within area when requested.
 - Total \$52/each. Total \$416. Table top rack. Look on NA.org if needing dimensions.
 - Vote approved 6-5 1 abstention. Vote passes
 - Whatever groups need this come to area to request
- Naws Meeting Updates
 - Scott F. Made changes in world services database. New system hasn't went live yet. Using zip code finder. If you put in zip code it will go to the area website
 - Groups need to look at information on website and make sure everything is correct so that it can be updated
- February 10th H&I/PR Fundraiser
 - Area meeting will begin at 11:30.
 - Valentine's Theme Fundraiser to follow.
 - Will send out flyer as soon as I receive it.

New Business

- Chair/Elected Positions
 - All positions are 1 year terms.
 - Chair position is now open. April will continue through February. Chair position will be open after that.
- Budget for subcommittee projects yearly
 - Would like for Area to provide service body direction on projects (basic texts going into institutions) will cost money. Service committee should have a budget set so that anything over \$199 doesn't have to always go back to groups for approval.
 - Would like to have an established budget every year to take back to groups for approval.
 - Discussion to set adhoc subcommittee. No need for ADhoc committee. Should have a budget so groups know that's the money we should be using to support our 7th tradition.
 - Take back to groups for discussion to see if having a formal budget for area would be appropriate.
- Request for funds for basic texts books
 - Available funds \$1800. Purchase of 90 basic text books total with 7 spanish.
 - To include 30 intro guides \$2.15/ea= \$64.50, 30 white booklets 80c= \$99 total. \$1232.94 = Would leave \$589
 - May need to adjust totals of books to allow for spanish where needed
- Plain States Zonal workshops on issue discussion topics
 - Tonia R. attended zoom workshops on General Neutral Language, Dealing with disruptive behavior
 - Does our area want to host workshops or have groups discuss these topics? Is there willingness in the next year?
 - Discussion about June 15th service assembly in marquette that covers some of these topics (see attached flyer)
 - Eureka group will be discussing more
